


- Direct Delivery Team Community Learning Programmes in Learning Centres, Schools, Children's Centres and Village Halls.

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## Move on Up

- ◆ There are a total of 62 learners currently enrolled on a Move on Up programme with AL&S.
- 26 learners currently over the age of 55.
- ◆ 17 of these learners are aged over 65.
- People with learning disabilities, particularly those with Down's syndrome, are at increased risk of developing dementia.







