#### **Environmental Education Trail**



#### Sauerland-Soaring

Long-distance hiking trail from Meinerzhagen to Korbach, 250 km

Is the highest rated hiking trail in the Sauerland region: The Sauerland-Soaring. One leg of this popular trail passes over Hegenscheid, located at a height of 473 meters above sea level, promises outstanding views all the way to the Ebbe Mountains. Only flying is better! - By the way, that's possible too: with a sightseeing round trip flight from Hegenscheid Airfield.

# The Wire Trade Route (Drahthandelsweg)

Themed hiking trail from Iserlohn via Altena (15 km) to Lüdenscheid, 32 km

As an industrially historical hiking trail, the 32-kilometer Wire Trade Route connects the cities of Iserlohn, Altena, and Lüdenscheid. At various points along the route hikers are shown the history of the wire traders and their difficulties along the way. The trail can be walked in two stages.

#### Ruhr-Lenne-Achter

Length: approximately 67.5 km

Difficulty: low gradient

The Ruhr-Lenne-Achter connects the Sauerland and the Ruhr area with a charming, flat leveled 70-kilometer cycling route. Following the rivers and streams of the region it promises a family-friendly sport and nature experience with industrial-cultural charm. #### Dirt-Bike-Park in Letmathe

The Dirt Bike Park in Letmathe is located directly on the Lenne River near the rock formation "Pater und Nonne" (Father and Nun). On a 4,800 m² pump track and two dirt lanes, children and teenagers can have fun on their bikes.

The Bismarck Tower in Seilerwald is 338 meters above sea level and can be visited at any time; however to go inside and climb, prior arrangements must be made with the city information center.





Access to the tower is only possible when the panoramic restaurant is open.




